Basic Functions:

Under the direction, conducts a health services program for the purpose of meeting the individual health needs of students; incorporating plans directed by physicians; strengthens the education process by improving and protecting the health status of students, providing health management plans for students with medical and physical disabilities complying with the law, including parental/guardian consent; promoting needed treatment; providing appropriate care for ill, medically fragile and injured student; providing health information and serving as a resource to teachers, staff, and administrators; identifying health problem and referring for proper treatment; evaluating, the protection of the health of pupils and school personnel is done in accordance with state laws, the board of registered nursing, and district accordance with state laws and district policies and procedures.

Representative Duties:

- 1. Serves as a member of the Educational Assessment Service Team and implements the health aspects of the Individualized Educational Plans for handicapped children.
- 2. Audiological screening for students in first, second, fifth, eight, and tenth grade.
- 3. Vision screening for students in first, second, fifth, and eighth grade
- 4. Plans and schedules for examination by local community dentist, as a voluntary service, all students in grades kindergarten through sixth.
- 5. Cooperates with the Health Department in implementing the Child Health and Disability Prevention Program.
- 6. Assists pupils, parents and teachers to adapt to pupil's health problem, such as diabetes, epilepsy, allergy, nephrectomy, specialized health needs.
- 7. Provides specific health management plans for children with chronic/specialized health needs.
- 8. Serves as liaison to community agencies and medical care facilities.
- 9. Ensures compliance with state law regarding school health requirements including immunizations, health physicals and medications.
- 10. Provides health education and staff wellness programs.
- 11. Monitors security and safe administration of medications on school campus.
- 12. Promotes and assist in control of communicable diseases.
- 13. Assures the health and safety of the school students and staff.
- 14. Assist in the verification of pupil absences, as related to severe illness.
- 15. Assures that all drug misusers receive appropriate help.
- 16. Assures a well-nourished school population by planning and organizing a nutrition teacher-in-service program.
- 17. Helps protect the well being of children and youth by assisting with identification of pupils showing evidence of being abused.

- 18. Identify and report suspected child abuse to appropriate agency.
- 19. Complies and analyzes school health records, reports and statistical information as needed for the appropriate school health program.
- 20. Provides Mantoux Tuberculosis Testing (PPD) and Reading to Desert Sands Unified School District employees and volunteers following written procedures of the County of Riverside Health Services Agency, Department of Public Health.

Knowledge and Skills Required:

- Skills to operate required health screening equipment and administer health screening tests
- Knowledge of evaluative techniques; health rules and regulations
- Ability to communicate both written and verbal. Significant physical abilities include sitting for prolonged periods, lifting, carrying, reaching, handling, fingering, feeling, talking, hearing, normal conversation and other sounds, near and far visual acuity.
- Exercise professional judgment.

Education and Experience

Bachelor Degree (BSN) in nursing from an accredited college or university.

Minimum of 2 years experience in either school nursing, community health nursing, pediatric nursing or acute care nursing, including emergency room, operating room, ICU, Pediatric ICU.

- Tuberculosis clearance

- Valid CPR and First Aid; must be valid throughout employment

Physical Requirements and Working Conditions
